1. All entrants must be under 35 years on October 1st 2010 and must live within a 30-mile radius of Cambridge. Members of Cambridge Drawing Society are not eligible.

2. The two-dimensional artwork must be original and may be in any medium, produced on paper, canvas or board. The size must not exceed A1 (84.1 × 59.4cms). ANY subject material is permitted e.g. landscape, still life, portraiture, abstract etc

3. There is NO entry fee but a maximum of 3 entries per person is permitted..

4. **Initially, entries must be submitted by email in JPEG format no larger than 500KB per image, with only one picture per email. Please email to Karen Stamper, kestamper@yahoo.com. Mark your email as CJYA2010. In this order, please include your FULL NAME, postal ADDRESS, Tel No., the EXACT DIMENSIONS of your unframed picture in cms, the MEDIUM, the SUPPORT (e.g. paper, canvas) and the TITLE. If you intend submitting more than one image, please insert Entry No. 1., 2. or 3. after your name. Please do not include any information other than that requested.**

5. Finalists will be selected from the JPEG images and these artists will be requested to send in their original artwork, which may be received unframed. If you are asked to submit the original work please ensure that it is labelled with your name, address and telephone number on the reverse.

6. Closing date for receipt of email entries - October 2nd 2010.

Finalists will be notified by email on October 6th.

7. The winning pictures will be hung in the Cambridge Drawing Society Autumn Exhibition, to be held at the Leys School, Cambridge from October 23rd – 30th 2010.

8. The decision of the judges will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
